

FDA RULES FOR SMOKELESS TOBACCO SALES

Are you taking the necessary steps to prevent underage tobacco use?



Check photo I.D. of everyone under age 27 who attempts to purchase smokeless tobacco.



Only sell smokeless tobacco to customers age 18 and older.*



Only sell smokeless tobacco in a direct, face-to-face exchange.**



Do NOT give away free samples of smokeless tobacco unless in a “qualified adult-only facility” and in limited quantities.***



Do NOT break open smokeless tobacco packages to sell products in smaller amounts.



Do NOT sell smokeless tobacco without a health warning label.

***Retailers must also follow state or local tobacco laws, even if they are more restrictive. For example, in some states the minimum age is 19.**

****The sale of cigarettes, cigarette tobacco, and smokeless tobacco through vending machines and self-service displays is allowed in adult-only facilities where no person younger than 18 is permitted to enter. Please note that tobacco product vending machines are banned in some states.**
